

- 776 BC - The first Olympic games take place.
 - 600BC - Greek coins are introduced as currency.
 - 508BC - Democracy is introduced in Athens.
 - 431 BC - The wars between Athens and Sparta begin.
 - 146BC - Rome defeats Greece in the Battle of Corinth making it part of the Roman Empire.

empire - is the collective name for a group of countries ruled by a single person, government or country. The word comes from a Latin word, imperium, meaning government or rule.	civilisation -the society, culture, and way of life of a particular area.	kingdom - an area that is ruled by either a king or queen.
democracy -A form of government where citizens have a say in how they are ruled including choosing their leaders and deciding on laws.	ostracism - exclusion from a group.	paganism -a religion where more than one (many) gods are worshipped.
artefact - a man-made object, such as pieces of art or tools, that is of particular cultural, historical or archaeological interest.	Olympics -sporting events in which athletes participate in a variety of competitions.	ancient -very old; existing for many years.
