#### Aims

This policy aims to set out our approach to requiring a uniform that is of reasonable cost and offers the best value for money for parents and carers; whilst in accordance with the Equality Act 2010 does not discriminate on the grounds of sex, religion or belief and sexual orientation.

Our school uniform gives pupils a shared sense of identity. It consists of both branded and non-branded items so that cost is not a barrier to any parents or carers.

In line with statutory guidance from the Department for Education, we have a duty to ensure our uniform is affordable. As a result, we limit the number of items with distinctive characteristics such as branded items which can only be purchased from limited retailers.

Where possible, school will also provide branded kit for sporting events to avoid the need for additional uniform requirements for extra-curricular activities.

To minimise the financial impact, frequent changes to uniform specifications will be avoided.

Nearly-new uniform items are available from the school office for a donation and the PTFA has held second-hand uniform sales in school; both enable items of uniform to be recycled and acquired cheaply.

# Expectations

Pupils are expected to:

 Wear the correct uniform at all times (other than on specified non-school uniform days) while on the premises, travelling to and from school and at out-of-school events or trips organised by school or when they are representing school if required.

Parents and carers are expected to:

- Make sure their child has the correct uniform and P.E. kit which is clearly labelled with their child's name.
- If they wish to make an amendment to the Uniform Policy in relation to their child's protected characteristics, they should contact the headteacher, Miss Dewhurst.

Governors will ensure the Uniform Policy is:

- Appropriate for the school's context;
- Implemented fairly
- Takes account of parent and pupil views
- Offers a uniform that is appropriate, practical and safe for all pupils.

Appendix A lists our school uniform. As detailed on the list, items below are the only ones which need to have the school logo on or be school specific. Other items can be purchased from high street stores or supermarkets.

# Appendix A

# School Uniform 2024/2025

Only school-approved bags can be brought into the cloakrooms. We have two styles of school bags - a top opening traditional book bag and one that is a satchel-style. Due to storage space, these are the only bags permitted in school.

In the interests of safety, security and uniformity, the only jewellery children can wear is an inexpensive watch. Children must not wear any watch that can take / receive photos or messages. However, a watch that counts steps e.g. a Fitbit can be worn.

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. Long hair should be tied up at all times and any hairbands must be in school colours and of a very simple design. Tramlines and other artistic shavings are not permitted in children's hair.

#### P.E. Kit

All children need an indoor and outdoor kit throughout the year. P.E. kit should be either brought into school on a Monday and kept in the cloakroom until <u>Friday</u>, <u>or</u> brought in on P.E. days. You will be notified in advance of your child's P.E. days.

\*Year 5 & Year 6 pupils <u>only</u> can wear appropriate navy cycling shorts, these must be no shorter than mid-thigh length, navy leggings can also be worn.

Please note, other sports or activity wear is not part of our school uniform.

#### Forest School Kit

Throughout the school year, pupils have the opportunity to use our Forest School area. You will be notified in advance of which day / dates your child will be using this outside space.
