School Uniform

Only school-approved bags can be brought into the cloakrooms. We have two styles of school bags - a top opening traditional book bag and one that is a satchel-style. Due to storage space, these are the only bags permitted in school.

In the interests of safety, security and uniformity, the only jewellery children can wear is an inexpensive watch. Children must not wear any watch that can take / receive photos or messages. However, a watch that counts steps e.g. a Fitbit can be worn.

Make-up and nail polish are not permitted. Long hair should be tied up at all times and any hairbands must be in school colours and of a very simple design. Tramlines and other artistic shavings are not permitted in children's hair.

Reception to Year Five

Navy blue A-line skirt/pinafore or grey trousers Sky blue polo shirt (with the school logo) OR blue shirt and school tie Navy tight, white or grey socks Navy crew neck jumper or cardigan with the school logo Flat black shoes (no boots or trainers)

Year Six

Navy blue A-line skirt/pinafore or grey trousers
Blue shirt and school tie
Navy tights, white or grey socks
Navy v-neck jumper or cardigan with the school logo
Black shoes (no boots or trainers)

In the warmer months, particularly after Easter, blue gingham Summer dresses or grey shorts may be worn

P.E. Kit

All children need an indoor and outdoor kit throughout the year. <u>Please</u> <u>note, other sports or activity wear is not part of our school uniform</u>. You will be notified of P.E. days in due course.

Indoor kit

Shadow striped navy shorts **OR** appropriate navy cycling shorts (these must be no shorter than mid-thigh length) **OR** navy leggings

Navy dri-cool T-shirt with the school logo **OR** plain navy blue round necked t shirt

Trainers

Plain navy track pants or long leggings

Sky blue hoodie with the school logo

Please can we ask you to put names in every item of uniform which comes into school including coats, as well as P.E. and Forest School kits and footwear? Thank you.

Forest School Kit

Throughout the school year, pupils have the opportunity to use our Forest School area. You will be notified in advance of which day / dates your child will be using this outside space. If they are in Forest School, pupils can come to school wearing the appropriate clothing as detailed below; they should also bring a change of footwear and a bag to take any dirty footwear home.

Waterproof coat with a hood; long-sleeved top and long trousers (not T-shirt and shorts); old trainers, Wellington boots or any footwear suitable for muddy paths.

Please do not buy anything new, old or playing out clothes are ideal!

Swimming Kit

You will be informed in advance if your child will be having swimming lessons.

One piece swimming costume (no bikinis or two-piece costumes) **OR** swimming trunks (not swimming shorts)
